Schedule for Orientation Day

- Students in grade 10,11 and 12 will be attending on Thursday September 10th.
- Students in grade 8 and 9 will be attending Friday September 11th.

- Staff will be set up outside the main entrance to greet students. There will be two tables per grade set up and students will be asked to line up and social distance.
- Students will pick up their mask and timetable outside prior to entering the school and making their way to their first class.

Health Assessment

- A reminder that families are asked to sign a Health Assessment Agreement (attached to the email). Please complete this form and return it to school as soon as possible.
- If your child does not pass the daily health check
 - they must stay home
 - You must contact a health care provider (811, nurse practitioner, physician)
 - You must contact the principal and provide any direction provided by public health

Masks

- Masks will be required for staff and students when:
 - Riding the bus
 - In our hallways
- Exceptions will be made for students who cannot wear masks for medical reasons. Please contact the principal before coming to school if this is the case.

Visiting the School

- We would prefer you phone when possible rather than visiting in person.
- All parents and other visitors must use the front entrance of then school by the office.
- All parents and other visitors must wear a mask
- Do not visit the school if your are sick or have symptoms.
- Sanitize your hands when you enter.

Hand Washing

- There will be a lot of hand washing occurring everyday, when students arrive, before they eat, before they get on a bus, after using the washroom etc.
- Please have your child wash their hands before they leave for school.

Traffic Changes at CSS

- Transmountain is working behind the school, we anticipate that the work will be completed prior to Christmas break. To accommodate this construction we have re-routed the busses.
- Busses will be using the circle at the front of the school and we need this area to stay free of vehicles. We have set up an alternative parent drop off at the adjacent the front parking lot.
